Read Romans 8:3-4. How does knowing that Jesus fulfilled the law on your behalf change your understanding of grace? What does it mean for you to walk according to the Spirit?

Reflect on Philippians 2:13. How is God currently working in you to accomplish His good pleasure?



Meditate on John 6:29. What does it mean to believe in Jesus as the "first work"? How can you strengthen your faith in what He has already accomplished?

Read Romans 8:14-17. What does it mean to be a child of God, adopted into His family? How does this truth affect how you live?

Serving from Sonship

Reflect on Luke 15:25-32, the story of the prodigal son's older brother. Do you ever find yourself serving out of obligation rather than love? How can you shift to serve from the security of being the beloved of the

Lord?

Bible Study Journal Prompts

Jesus' Enduring Love

Pray through 1 Corinthians 13:7. Jesus' love bears, believes, hopes, and endures all things. How does this truth provide comfort and strength in your current season?



Reflect on Hebrews 4:9-11. What is He calling you to release so that you can experience His rest and peace more fully?

God's Love in Action

Meditate on Ephesians 2:10. How is God calling you to walk in the good works He's prepared for you?

Trusting in the Finished Work of Christ Read John 19:30. How do you trust in the finished work of Christ in moments of doubt or anxiety? How does His declaration of "It is finished" impact your faith journey today?

Hope and Endurance

Reflect on Romans 5:3-5. How has God used suffering in your life to grow endurance, character, and hope? Write about how His love has carried you through difficult times.
